AERO Chocolate Allergen Changes

Nestlé Australia would like to advise you of some important changes affecting AERO Chocolate.

As you may be aware, AERO Chocolate has previously been suitable to consume if you follow a diet free of wheat, peanuts and tree nuts.

For several reasons, one of which is to provide a fresher product to our consumers, we have moved the production of AERO from the UK to Australia. As a result, from **February 2011**, the AERO Milk and Peppermint 40g bars, 118g blocks, and the new AERO Peppermint King Size 60g will carry a statement saying **“Made on equipment that processes products containing wheat, peanuts and tree nuts”**.

To identify the new formulation, on the front of the packaging the Milk AERO will state “NEW, Smoother and Creamier” and the Peppermint AERO will state “No Artificial Colours”. If you have an allergy to wheat, peanuts and tree nuts, unfortunately we would advise you NOT to consume the new AERO products.



Whilst we understand that this change will cause disappointment to many of our consumers who suffer from these allergies, we have only come to this decision after much deliberation.

Nestlé acknowledges there is limited choice for those consumers who suffer from these allergies. For those who need to avoid peanuts and/or tree nuts, you may like to try Nestlé ROLO 50g tube (made in the UK) or Nestlé Mint Pattie, and for those avoiding wheat, you may like to try Nestlé Scorched Almonds and Nestlé Melts and Bits. Remember to read the ingredient list and precautionary statement of each and every product you purchase every time.
