Nestlé Baby Food Recall - Misleading Email

There is a misleading email circulating about a recall of Nestlé baby food. To reassure any concerned parents, here are the facts:

On June 29, Nestlé France voluntarily recalled one batch (n° L 10980295) of Nestlé P'tit Pot Recette Banana, a baby food product sold in glass jars. The specific product batch was recalled as a precautionary measure when Nestlé was contacted by a consumer who had found glass in a jar.

The product batch was **only sold in France** and **no other product batches** and **no other countries** were affected by this recall.

The quality and safety of our products are non-negotiable priorities for us, so we immediately took all necessary measures to establish the cause of this incident in close collaboration with authorities in France. The conclusion of the investigation was that this was an isolated case involving one jar.
